You will get

- Support during placement to develop knowledge, understanding and skills.
- A tailor-made personal development plan.
- One-to-one advice on further opportunities, including volunteering at other places.
- The support of a well respected, friendly organisation with experienced and dedicated staff.



We ask that you

- During training – commit one full day per week for six weeks
- During placement – a minimum commitment of two hours per week for three months
- If you are unable to attend, you should keep us informed.

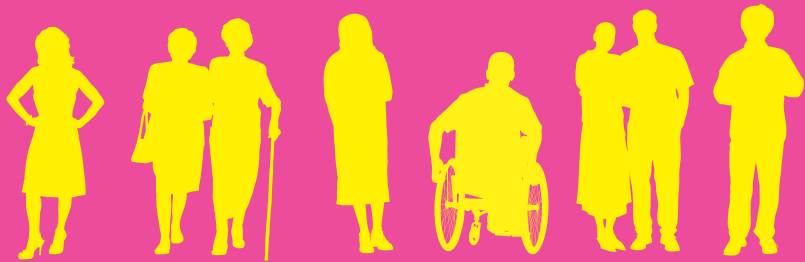
